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1

IDENTIFY

Identify what proposed regulations you are commenting on by section number or topic.



2

SUBMIT

Submit your comment within the designated comment period indicated on the Agency's website.

3

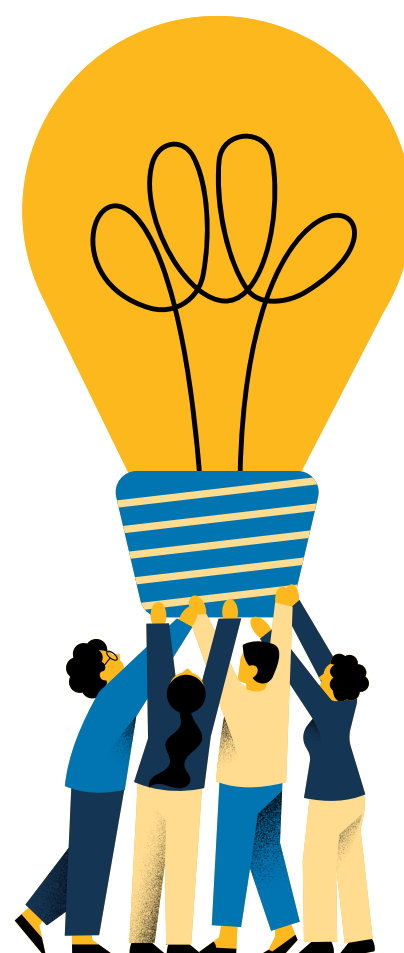
COMMENT

Written and oral comments are treated equally and counted once. Duplicative comments are treated as one no matter how many times you submit.

4

FOCUS

Focus your comment on the proposed regulations. Comments related to other topics will not be considered in the rulemaking, so save them for other future related rulemakings.



5

PRIVACY

Only include information that you are comfortable sharing with the public. Comments become part of the public record and are available for members of the public to review.

6

EMAIL

Email is faster. If you submit your comment by email, or provide an email address for notices during your oral comment, you will receive notices about changes to the proposed regulations faster than through other methods.
